

Will of Henry Lyell (1665-1731)

In the Name of God Amen

Henry Lyell of London Merchant being in good health and
of sound and disposing mind and memory Considering the uncertainty
of this life do therefore make and declare this my last Will and
Testament and do give and dispose of my Estate wherewithal it lieth
planted by me to the best of my knowledge and judgment of my just debts as
followeth that is to say first I give to Elizabeth my daughter now
the sum of One thousand pounds then I give to Mrs Elizabeth
Lyell the sum of One thousand pounds and it being my meaning
intention and will that no Relation or Person whatsoever should
have any part of the residue of my Estate but my Son and Doring
Brother Walter Lyell I do therefore give all the rest and
residue of my Goods Chattels Debts money and all other my Estate
whatsoever and whatsoever unto my said Doring Brother Walter
Lyell his Executors and Administrators and I do make and
appoint my said Doring Brother Walter Lyell sole Executor
of this my Will And I do hereby revoke and make void all former
Wills by me at any time heretofore made and I make and declare
this only to be my last Will and Testament to witness whereof
I the said Henry Lyell have to this my last Will and Testament
contained in this sheet of written paper set my hand and seal
this fourteenth day of November anno Domini 1727. And in the
first year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Second
By the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King
Defender of the Faith &c. Henry Lyell. signed sealed published
and declared by the said Henry Lyell the Testator for and as
his last Will and Testament on the day of the date thereof in the
